**Call to Order:** The West Middlesex Borough Work Session meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by the Borough Council President, Mr. Tim Webster

**Street Department Report:** Mr. Bill Schwartz was not present to read the Street Department Report. President, Mr. Tim Webster informed all of Council that a copy of the Street Department Report is in their packet of information, and asked Council to reviews the report and follow up with Bill with any questions or concerns.

**Street Improvement Project:** Council members discussed all of the streets to be included in the bid package. The ADA Ramps were discussed. Mr. Bollinger talked about a different type of ADA crosswalks that might be less expensive. It was discussed to have PennDOT breakdown the bid package into 3 separate totals. 1. Erie Street: Main to Walnut. 2. Walnut Street. 3. Oak Hill Ext. This item will be on the agenda for the Council meeting for a vote on the changes to the bid package, and to advertise.

**Penn Ave Project Update:** Council discussed the Penn Ave project. Everything is on schedule. The home owners have not issued an appeal.

**Garfield Street Project:** A quote was calculated and submitted to Council from Mr. Bill Schwartz with a break down on the cost to do the project in house.

**Maintenance Agreement with WM Estates:** Council discussed going forward that there should be a maintenance agreement on maintenance and repairs on the Pump Station. As of yet, the owners have not had the lines inspected. Attorney Tesone will be asked if an Ordinance would need to be put in place.

**Street Cleaning Quotes:** Two quotes were received. One from Hermitage, and one from Farrell. This item will be on the Council meeting to be voted on. It was discussed in favor of the City of Farrell due to the good relationship we are forming since entering the Police Contract.

**911 EMS Rotation Update.** Council woman Mrs. Cristal Bollinger updated the Council that a questioner has been sent to McGonigal, Elite and Shenango Twp. She is still waiting for the completed information from Shenango Twp.

**ARLE Grant Pre-Application:** The pre application has been submitted with the request for the battery back-up for the red light. At this time, the Borough is still waiting to hear back if the pre-application has been accepted.

**Red-White & Blue Glow Parade:** The start time for the parade was discussed. The start time will be 8:30 pm. Once the parade is over and the festivities at the gazebo begin, it will be darker and allow the lighting of the red white and blue lights.
