Call to Order: The West Middlesex Borough Work Session meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by the Borough Council President, Mr. Tim Webster

Pledge of Allegiance

Street Department

Street Department Report: Senior Laborer Bill Schwartz was not present. Mr. Webster informed all that the street department report could be found in the Council folders.

Update on WM Estates Cement Pad: Mr. Webster informed Council that the pad is scheduled to be done next week. Mr. Bollinger questioned why it is taking so long. I was to be done a month ago. Mr. Bollinger will check with Bill. He reported he is tired of people bidding jobs and not doing them He referred to Donatelli Electric with the lights on Main Street. As per the cement pad, Mr. Bollinger feels it could have at least of been formed. He will check with Bill tomorrow and check on this.

Blinker Lights for School Street: Mr. Bollinger will check with Bill on this also.

Speed Limit Signs for Main Street: Mr. Bollinger will check with Bill. Paula will email Buddy tomorrow concerning the location of speed limit signs.

Updates on Lights on Bridge and Main Street: Mr. Bollinger will reach out to Bill to contact Donatelli Electric to find out what the situation is on the lights.

- Mayor Stacey Curry informed Council that the sewer grate in front of her house looks cleaned out, however the rain water was backing up. Possible it needs cleaned out inside.

Update on Road Closed Signs: Mr. Bollinger updated Council that Home Depot is not doing any donations at this time. Mr. Ritter reported that he has extra 2x4's. He can build the frames, and said that he will work with Mr. Bollinger to get them made.

Road Salt-Pre Order Discount: Secretary, Paula Luca, updated Council that if a pre-order is placed before November 1st, we would receive a 5% discount. We have 50 tons left over from last year. This item will be placed on the Council Meeting Agenda for the vote to pre-order to receive a discount.

Trailor Registration: The renewal of the registration was discussed. Also, the use of the trailer was discussed. The cost for the registration is \$15 for the year. Mr. Bollinger updated Council that he inquired with the local trailer sales to see if they would be interested in buying the trailer. But he reported that the tag has been removed. Secretary, Paula Luca suggested that the # will be on the registration paperwork.

Storm Sewer Grates: Mr. Rankin feels that all of the storm sewers need cleaned off and cleaned inside. Not all of them, but they should all be checked and cleaned if needed.

Part Time Laborer Position: This item will be on the Council Meeting Agenda. Mr. Bollinger added that he did speak with George, our Union Rep. He was informed of the information concerning a Council Member being employed by the Borough. Mr. Bollinger added, if he is considered for the position, he will step down from Council if needed.

Street Improvement Project: Council is still waiting to hear on the start date for the project.

Penn Ave Project Update: The property has been posted by Mr. Richardson that the property is unsafe. Attorney Tesone is working with the Court.

Parcel # 75 800 093: The Borough is waiting on the deed to be processed at the Court House. The property is located across from the gazebo. The property was purchased for \$1.00. Mayor Stacey Curry suggested , that the property will be a better placed for the community garden beginning next year.

Skilled Games License Application: Attorney Tesone will advise Council how to move forward on the Ordinance for the application for the skilled games. However, the state is currently in a 4-month time period to decide if the machines will be taxed through the state and if they will be illegal going forward.

Time Capsule August 19, 2026: The time capsule is scheduled to be buried on August 19th at 7:00 pm.
