- **Late Fee:** 1% on accounts over 90 days past due

 - Local bank: First National Bank – West Middlesex Branch
 - Borough Office
 - Mail
 - Secure drop box at Borough Office
 - Direct deposit (set up at Borough Office)
- Residents with **past due sewer bills** are encouraged to contact the Borough office to arrange a **payment plan**.

⚠ **Please note:** If a payment plan is not set up, a **municipal lien may be placed on the property** until the account is paid in full. Setting up a plan now can help avoid this step! We are here to work with you!
